



PICKLEBALL ETIQUETTE



- Rotate after each game, this way everyone gets a chance to get time on the court.
- If you must walk across one court area to get to another, wait until the rally is over then ask to "come through."
- Before serving, make sure that the receiver is ready and facing you.
- If a ball comes into your court please stop play and return it to the proper person. Do not just smack it back without looking.
- Do not call faults that occur on the other side of the court unless asked to do so. It is the responsibility of the receiver's side of the net to make calls.
- Keep your temper. No abusive language is allowed.
- Compliments to your opponent's partner for a wellmade shot are always encouraged.
- For safety, proper court shoes are a must.
- When courts are full, players are to place their paddles in the paddle holder, which means they are waiting for a court to open.
- If there are paddles in the paddle holder, players who just finished their game should exit the court, so that the players waiting can enter the vacated court.
